# CodeRed EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

Recently, the City of Meadows Place Mayor and Council authorized the CodeRED Emergency Notification System

for City of Meadows Place residents and businesses. This is an extremely high speed telephone communication service that allows us to call targeted areas or the entire city in the event of an emergency or urgent situation that requires immediate attention.

The CodeRED system allows the city the ability to deliver pre-recorded emergency telephone notification/information messages to residents or businesses within a few short minutes. This is an especially valuable service during emergency events such as hurricanes, missing children or adults, water main breaks, road closings, law enforcement emergencies, health advisories, hazardous material spills - in short, any and all emergencies and community alerts. This does not mean the city will be calling you constantly. The system will only be used for emergency situations and the dissemination of information valuable to our residents and businesses.

If you have an unlisted phone number, privacy manager, have changed your phone number or address, or use a cellular phone as your home phone, you may not receive these important notifications. If you fall into these categories or would like to update or ensure your information is listed correctly, please contact the Meadows Place City Police Department at (281) 983-2900 between the hours of 9am-4pm Monday through Friday. In the near future residents and businesses will be able to access the city's website, <a href="www.cityofmeadowsplace.org">www.cityofmeadowsplace.org</a> and add or update their information to receive emergency notifications.

The information in the City of Meadows Place database is secure and confidential, and will only be used by the city for emergency notifications. This service is only available to City of Meadows Place residents and businesses. Meadows Place respects the privacy of each person within our community; therefore, if you do not wish to receive emergency notifications, please contact Meadows Place Police Department and request to be removed from the notification list. The CodeRED service should be operational within a few weeks, so please visit the city website and review future newsletters for more information.



# Meadows Community Improvement Association

The Meadows Community Improvement Association works with your City leaders on the following issues. All residents should review their situation to see if any of these apply to them and if so take appropriate steps to correct.

- Approval of all exterior painting; even if repainting the same color-Failure could result in repainting and added expense
- Trash cans visible from the street
- Inoperable gas lanterns-either repair or have removed if no longer working. Many are rusted and bent resulting in an unsightly view from the street
- Basketball goals, free standing or those fixed in ground should be kept maintained with both functioning backboard and net around the hoop.
- Overgrown trees with branches hanging over sidewalks and or neighbors driveways-it is important that large heavy branches that may be weak and that could break during strong wind be trimmed so as not to fall/damage your neighbors property or vehicles

Compliance in regard to following issues is also required

- Approval of roof colors at City Hall
- Approval of all exterior siding colors
- Stumps level with the ground so grass can grow over the area
- \* Rotten wood and peeling paint should be repaired
- AC units in windows visible from the street are not permitted
- Approval of all exterior changes to a home
- Other areas that could be deemed a "nuisance" to the neighborhood

A comment! Mail boxes should be maintained and kept in good conditions and upright not only for esthetic purposes but also so that the mail person can easily insert the mail.


A reminder! all house numbers should be visible on all homes. This is important if emergency personnel need to come to your home. A reminder for all residents to make an effort to make sure that their residence has visible numbers on the house or mail box and on the curb.

### **ATTENTION TENNIS PLAYERS**

Please take a moment to read the tennis rules sign located at the tennis court. All rules will be enforced and violators will be subject to forfeiture of their privileges to use City facilities. The access card reader installed at the entrance gate will read every card and allow or deny access. The memory in the card reader gives the Parks and Recreation Office the information as to what resident's card was swiped at any given time of the day. It has been observed on a regular basis that too many guests or even non-resident use may be going on. Upon observation of such occurrence and notification to the Parks Department, we will research access information. This information will enable the Parks Office to contact the card holder to discuss possible violation of the access card rules.

If you see suspicious use of the tennis courts, or anyone violating the rules, please take note of the time of day and the possible violation and contact the Parks Department. You can call and leave a detailed message 24 hrs a day. Your personal name and information is optional. We will investigate the situation and contact you, if you wish, as well as the prospective violator.




