Elections


community as well as building a country." I could not agree more. Another consideration is that all our County, State, and Federal officials know who votes - and we need to be known as a community that does, so please, exercise your right to vote and make Meadows Place proud.

Tactical Training Center

The City of Meadows Place Police Department is about to move into a new era. We are nearing completion of the conversion of the Annex on Kirkwood into our new Police Department Tactical Training Center. Public Works Director Dan McGraw conferred with Training Officer Captain Gary Stewart to make sure the annex could be utilized for such a purpose. Once it was determined that it would work, a planning meeting was held to determine the best layout and then the gutting and rebuilding of the building began. It is a fairly substantial job which not only includes a great deal of structural rework, but it also includes a number of lighting and technological upgrades. Fortunately, due to the extra effort on the part of Dan McGraw and our Public Works Department, we are able to cover this cost out of our normal building and maintenance budget. Once complete, it will be used for training with the new high tech, laser based training system we obtained through a grant. This system is an outstanding tool that will allow our officers to train more often in a myriad of high stress scenarios so they will be even more effective in their efforts to protect us. Another bonus is that we will cut the amount of live ammunition purchased every year by 50%. The details have not been worked out, but once complete and operational, we plan to have an Open House.

Is Your Vehicle Safe?

A uto Burglary is a "Crime of Opportunity." Every 2 ½ minutes in Texas, another vehicle is broken into. To protect the citizens of Meadows Place from becoming a victim of this type of crime, Meadows Place Police Department has initiated a Burglary of Motor Vehicle (BMV) protection through education program.

This program, known as T-L-C, reminds Meadows Place residents and visitors to:

Take Out Valuables Lock Your Vehicle Close Your Windows

As part of the program, Meadows Place Police Officers randomly check vehicles parked in city streets, driveways and business parking lots for items that would attract a potential burglar and make the vehicle owner a crime victim. After inspecting the vehicles for valuables left in plain sight and after checking for unlocked doors or open windows, the officer fills out the "Report Card" portion of the educational brochure. When possible, the officer will review the findings with the owner to make sure they understand the importance of this project and how a little T-L-C can help protect them and their neighbors in the future. If the owner is not available, the officer will leave it on the windshield of the vehicle indicating whether the vehicle passed or failed. If a vehicle fails, the officer will clearly indicate the reason for the failure. In addition to the Report Card, the brochure contains numerous crime prevention tips and other valuable information.

This is a proactive crime prevention initiative designed to educate Meadows Place citizens and visitors alike. If everyone follows the guide attached to the report card, we can reduce the chance that anyone will ever become a victim of this very preventable crime. Remember, if we all practice T-L-C, it will force the burglars to shop somewhere else!
