Happy New Year

Please allow me to say how pleased I am that 2014 was such a good year for The City of Meadows Place. First I need to thank the dedicated employees that work so hard to make our little Apple Pie community the wonderful city it is. I would also like to thank the members of City Council and all the residents who volunteer for city Boards

and Commissions. These folks are an important part of city government and are vital in making sure Meadows Place is .. Your Place for Life.

In no particular order, I would like to share some of the accomplishments of 2014 then mention a few things for 2015:

ISO 1 Fire Rating

The Class 1 rating is a noteworthy accomplishment as we are one of less than 90 cities in the whole country to achieve this rating. Our little city doing big things.

West Airport Project

Finally- the construction began. This project is big for our city as it is part of a Fort Bend Mobility Bond project. Additionally, the city was able to secure some federal funding which saved us hundreds of thousands of dollars. Should be done in April 2015.

Meadows Place chosen for survey

University of Houston Rn to BSN program chose Meadows Place to conduct a major "windshield survey". It was very interesting and gave us some great insight into our city. The best part – they loved our city!

Meadows Place Bond Rating Raised - Again



She wanted to tell me about two of our neighbors who went way beyond just being neighborly to look after a house and yard when the owner was no longer able to. It "didn't look like Meadows Place" she said, but now it does again. She did not want names mentioned, but they are certainly folks that help make Meadows Place, *Your Place for Life*.

Speaking of good neighbors... **Did You Know**, there is an 84 year old who walks down to the corner to sweep up all the leaves that gather at the drain? They do it so that the homeowner doesn't have to do it all the time. That is also a pretty nice, and special neighbor.

Did You Know... that City Secretary Jan Moore has received her City Clerk certifications? These are not just handed out to everyone who applies-they are earned. The certification program is difficult and part of professional career development by the Texas Municipal Clerks Association. The program provides insight into public relations, communications, as well as increasing knowledge in the areas of State Laws and City Codes. Congratulations Jan!

Did You Know... Meadows Place has an official No Smoking policy for all of our city owned buildings and within 50 ft of outside entrances and windows? We haven't needed one in the past, but now with the liquid nicotine and e-cigarettes, we had to pass an ordinance because e-smokers were "smoking" in our lobby and community center.

Did You Know... The Meadows Home and Garden Club has expanded its Yard of the Month awards to run from April through November? It will continue to award patriotic displays for the Fourth of July and Christmas holiday displays in December. Thanks to everyone who works so hard to make these awards possible and to the homeowners who work so hard to make our city look so beautiful.

Did You Know... John Rowell, who grew up in Meadows Place, was put on the Freshman USA Division II College Football All-American Team? This is quite a feat. I know Mom and Dad (James and Mary) are very proud. So are we. Congratulations John!

Did You Know... one way you can help keep our city the best it can be, is to help our code enforcement officer spot code violations? Jerry Parker, our code enforcement official, is very good at what he does and is more interested in code compliance than he is in issuing a citation. That is great, and the way it should be, but even Jerry will tell you, every once in a while he misses one. That is where you come in. There is a spot on the website for you to point out possible code violations to him. Just fill out the Code Violation form on the website – one possible violation per submission please – and that is all there is to it. You will need the address of course, and will have to leave your contact information, but rest assured, we take steps to maintain anonymity.

Did You Know... Meadows Place has updated our food safety and food control regulations? Last month we had a meeting at City Hall with the food preparers in the city. Great meeting. They had a chance to review all at once and ask questions of our food service inspector, Sandra Serra, with Food Safety International.(FSI), one of the premier health inspection companies around. She is so good she teaches health inspection classes! She's very fair – but very tough and very diligent. We want to make sure Meadows Place restaurants are not only delicious places to eat, but safe. Fortunately, we have wonderful restaurants and food providers.

A few other great things...

We became the first city in the region to transition to full radio read water meters. Our Council worked with our Planning & Zoning and recently passed an ordinance requiring cross (traffic) access in future developments. We had over \$1,000,0000 in commercial improvements this year and, we got two free hummers. Our Economic Development Corporation (EDC) met with Council and has hired a marketing firm to help promote Meadows Place.

Congressman Pete Olson made an official announcement from Meadows Place and we saw the creation of a Community Garden Association. There was a major upgrade in our Waste Water Treatment Plant and City Hall got a facelift (thanks to EDC). Our 25th annual Christmas Memories was the best ever! The city had an election and has regained its status as a community that votes. We are a city that gets big things done and stays within its budget! This list could go on but let me just say Thank You to our Council, our PD, the Parks and Public Works staff, and everyone in our Utilities, Courts and Finance departments for making this such a great year, but most of all, let me Thank You, for letting me be Mayor in 2014.

Be Aware and Be Safe

Tow more than ever is the time to be conscious

wares. Whether you are traveling out of town, just out for the evening, or shopping by yourself or with children, below are a few precautions to help make your outings safer.

If you are traveling:

- Put an automatic timer on your lights
- Ask a neighbor to check up on your home
- Don't forget to have your mail and newspaper delivery stopped
- Contact Meadows Place Police Department and request a House Watch

If you are out of the house:

- Turn on lights and music or the TV so it looks as if someone is home
- Be sure that your doors and windows are locked
- If you plan to have packages delivered to your home, make sure you are home to accept them. If not, ask a neighbor or have the package be sent to the nearest post office.

If you are shopping:

- Stay alert and be aware of what's going on around you
- Park in a well-lit space
- Be sure to lock your car, close windows, and hide shopping bags in the trunk
- Avoid carrying large amounts of cash; pay with a check or credit card whenever possible
- Don't overburden yourself with packages
- Deter pickpockets and purse-snatchers. Carry a purse close to your body in the front. If you are carrying a wallet, place it in an inside coat or front pants pocket
- If shopping with kids, have a plan in case you get separated. For the older children, have a central meeting spot designated. For the younger children teach them to go to a store clerk or security guard if you get separated. Be sure they know your name (not just mommy and daddy), cell phone number, and their address. Go over the dangers of strangers with them so they know who not to talk to or follow
- Check receipts to see whether your full credit card number appears. If a receipt has your full number on it, take a pen and thoroughly scratch it out
- Double check that you have your credit cards and check book after you pay for your items

By following these tips, you can reduce your stress and be safe at the same time and make it a safe one.



Each position is for a two (2) year term. In addition to the Council Workshops and Meetings held on the 4th Tuesday of each month, the City Council also meets for special workshops and meetings throughout the year.

Deadline to File An Application for Place on the Ballot:

Start Date:	Wednesday, January 28, 2015 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
End Date:	Friday, February 27, 2015 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Candidate Eligibility General Requirements

A candidate must:

(1) be a United States Citizen;

(2) be 18 years of age or older on the first day of the term to be filled at the election;

(3) have resided continuously in the state for 12 months and in the city or in the district or ward, as applicable, for six months immediately preceding the deadline for filing an application for a place on the ballot (for a write-incandidate, preceding the date of the election) [Election Code §141.001(s)].

(4) must be a registered voter and must have resided within the municipal limits for at least the 12 months preceding the election day.

Tennis Court Access System

Residents may purchase new Tennis Court access cards at City Hall, Monday through Friday, 9 am to 4 pm.

- Only residents of Meadows Place may purchase a card.
- A driver's license and/or water bill verifying Meadows Place residency must be shown to purchase the access card.
- Access cards are \$50 per card, maximum 2 cards per family.
- Cards are valid through May; old cards will be deactivated at the end of May.
- All tennis players must have access card with them while on the courts.
- A maximum of three (3) guests allowed per card and all guests must be accompanied by a resident.
- Do not prop open the gate at any time or allow access to the courts to anyone without a Tennis Court access card.

Failure to comply with all rules posted at the Tennis Courts and on the Registration Card may result in forfeiture of Access Cards.



- *Why:* Public Works Department will recycle the trees.









as he handed the good boys and girls a stuffed Christmas puppy!










