Public Hearing

You are invited to a Public Hearing which will be held at 7:00 on Mar. 23rd at City Hall. We are seeking public opinion about the possibility of amending our Zoning ordinances to address Tattoo and Body Piercing Studios within the City limits of Meadows Place. Our current zoning ordinance does not prohibit these establishments. Mayor and Council feel it prudent to pursue discussions on this topic

and invite anyone with an opinion to join them at this Public Hearing. Both Council and the Planning and Zoning Board are anxious to hear public input before taking any action but Council will be 'calling' the Public Hearing at the Council Meeting on Feb.23rd. Join us.

On The Ballot

On the ballot in the May 8th election will be a proposal to convert our Economic Development Corporation (EDC) from a type 4A to a type 4B. The Meadows Place Economic Development Corporation was established to examine the various ways in which commercially zoned property within the City could be made more attractive for business development. The goal of the EDC is to attract financially secure businesses which could add to the City's property tax base, generate sales tax revenue, and have a value-added benefit to the residents. Due to legislative changes, the 4B option is more...

'small town' friendly and allows broader use of the funds for our city's economic development and improvement. Our EDC is operated by a five member Board which is chaired by Mayor Pro Tem Terry Henley. Among other things, it has been active in securing our third water well and sound walls. Important items to be sure. Now we need to make some long range plans and believe the 4B option is worthy of consideration. Progress Report

I wanted to update everyone on the West Airport – Kirkwood reconstruction project. We are completing the Engineering Selection process for the West Airport portion of the project. By the time this is published the process may be complete and a firm selected. We received applications from 33 firms. This is a huge number for such a small job. Big for us – but small overall. I would like to thank Steve Gardner, Jason Vaughn and Dan McGraw for serving on the selection committee. This was a LONG and complicated process. Once the selection is awarded and plans are being made for West Airport, we will turn our attention to the Kirkwood portion of the project. It is our hope to bid both portions together to take advantage of construction cost savings. We will have a more complete update next month so be sure to check your Newsletter. We will also be posting news on the website.

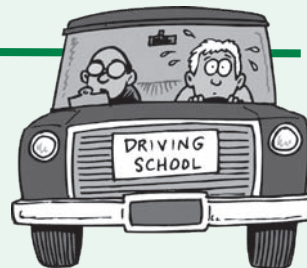

The topic of discussion was the future of Commuter Rail along the 90A corridor. It was quite interesting and very intense. March is MAILBOX MONTH!

Shortly before I began working in our city, Tracey Spiller held our first annual mailbox month. Tracey was impressed with the results, and I was as well. Let's get this decade kicked off right by rising to the challenge once again...

Mailboxes are constructed to last only about 10 years (depending on materials used). The United States Postal Service states that it is the individual homeowner's responsibility to maintain and replace worn or damaged mailboxes. If it's been quite awhile since you've replaced yours then take an objective look at it. Remember that your mailbox is oftentimes the "first impression" to the house that you've made a home.



HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

Through the month of March; mail, place in utility billing box, or email (code-enforcement@cityofmeadowsplace.org) a before and after picture of your newly rejuvenated or replaced mailbox to City Hall. Each participant will receive \$5 discount off their water bill!

Some mailboxes will only need updating and maintenance; paint, rust removal, up-righting post; adding address numbers...), while others may need replacing. Hardware stores sell replacement kits at reasonable prices, and with reasonable effort you can have a fresh new look.

CURBSIDE MAILBOX STANDARDS:

- The bottom of the mailbox should be located between 41 – 45 inches (vertical height) from the surface of the street.
- The name and address on your mailbox should be at least 1 inch high.
- The front of your mailbox door should be located 6 – 8 inches from the front face of the curb.

Contact our local post office directly if you are considering moving the location of your mailbox.

The Meadows Place Police Department is in the process of implementing the Nixle Municipal Wire for information, notification and Alerts for and about the City of Meadows Place. The service allows the police department to disseminate important or critical information in a timely fashion about events and activities taking place within the city.

The service does require registration, a process which consists of name, email, area of interest, alerts types of interest and how you would like to receive the notifications. You may visit Nixle.com for further information and registration, which includes an instructional video also. The process allows one to enter information about the types of information desired. You may register for different areas such as Meadows Place and Stafford. The message may be received via email or cell phone (as a text which may incur a charge from your carrier)

Nixle's Municipal Wire is the first standardized, secure, and certified communication platform for local police departments, municipalities, and their agencies to communicate important, neighborhood-level information to the residents of their communities. Nixle's Municipal Wire is available at no cost to agencies or police departments, and uses the same compelling model as social applications, such as Twitter and Facebook, while adding the security that is critical to ensure information received by users is Trusted and Accurate.

Residents receive all information immediately by text message, email and web.

As the sun rose on Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day 2009, the streets of Meadows Place took on a bold new patriotic look. Over one hundred fifty residents are subscribers to Troop 1115's Flag Service. Some of our streets woke up to see that more than half of the homes presented a prominent Red, White and Blue, high quality flag, proudly flying from a tall straight flag pole which was securely and uniformly placed just off the curb in front of each subscriber's home.

We wish to express our sincere Thank You to those who have subscribed to this Flag Service, for supporting Troop 1115 and for expressing the patriotic spirit on the holidays when we honor America.

To those who have not yet subscribed, we extend this invitation and ask for your support. **(NOTE: Flags approved by the City of Meadows Place)**

Troop 1115 will proudly post an American Flag in front of your residence on each of the following national holidays: Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day. (On Veteran's Day, the scouts are usually in school so flags will NOT be placed in front of homes that day).

For subscribers, a flag holder (PVC pipe) will be placed underground in your front yard, approximately 18 inches back from the curb. On the morning of the four national holidays listed above, Troop 1115 will post an American Flag approximately three by five feet in size on a metal flagpole approximately 10 feet high. Troop 1115 will then return in the evening to retire the flag and flagpole and store it until the next holiday.

Note: The flags and flagpoles are the property of Troop 1115. You are purchasing a subscription service and NOT the flag or flagpole itself.

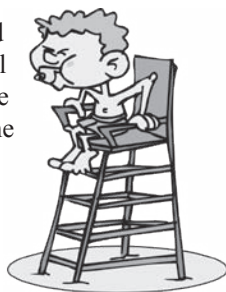

Message from the Pool Manager

Grab your bathing suits, goggles and sunscreen because the summer season is right around the corner! I just wanted to remind everyone of a few pool policies to ensure we all have a fun and safe summer.

- Please remember if you do not have a pool card, you cannot get into the pool. Access cards can be purchased at city hall, M-F 9:00a.m.-4:00 p.m. for \$10 each. Also, with every one pool card, you are allowed THREE guests, no exceptions. Only two pool cards are permitted per family.

- Remember to reapply sunscreen at least every 2 hours or so. It is important to protect your skin. Ask a lifeguard for sunscreen if you forgot yours at home. We don't want to see any more sunburned kiddos at the pool!

- The lifeguards are in charge at all times. Failure to obey the lifeguards can result in suspension from the pool.

- Appropriate swim wear is required. If you are concerned about you or your child's skin being too exposed to the sun, rash guards are permitted to be worn over the bathing suit.

- NEW POLICY! Children ages 8 and under MUST be accompanied by an adult or guardian. If your child is 8 or younger he or she cannot come to the pool by themselves.

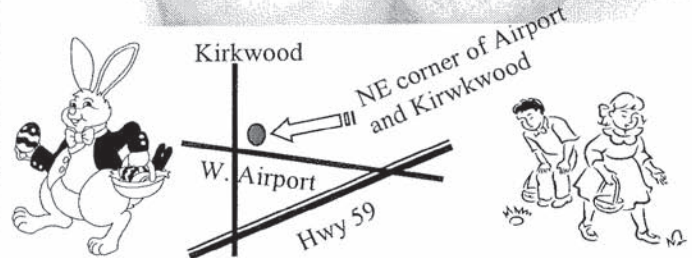

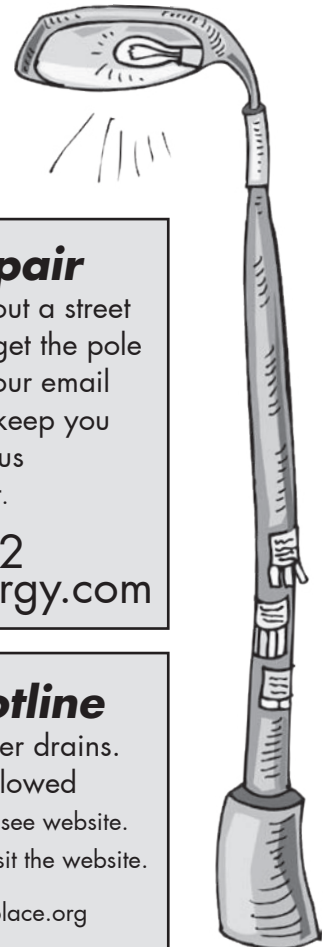
