Important Joint City Council / EDC Meeting

Last month your City Council and the Meadows Place Economic Development Corporation (EDC) met to discuss several important items. The topic that commanded the most attention and cooperation was the pre-public hearing discussion of the new Meadows Place

Community Development Program. Simply put, this is a joint venture operation between the city and our EDC, which allows the City of Meadows Place to purchase abandoned or substandard homes which meet specific guidelines of the program. The next step is for the house to be upgraded and renovated as needed and placed back on the market to be sold in a closed bid auction. When a house is selected and conditions for purchase are met, our EDC will fund the purchase and renovation. One of the points made at the Public Hearing is that we will NOT be using imminent domain to take anyone's house but following program guidelines. Thankfully Meadows Place doesn't have many of these homes but if all goes well, we will have a new tool to help us deal with them later this month. A program overview is posted on our website.

Another topic of discussion centered around the prioritization of several items laid out for the city by consultant Chris Hill of Imagination Monkey. Items discussed, in no particular order, included a city Facebook page, Realtor Branding, local Upgrade and Teardown Incentives, Events Assistance, Hike and Bike trails and utilizing and marketing our location as the Gateway to Fort Bend and the Gateway to Houston. There was great participation and appreciation of effort by both Council and EDC members as plans came together and items were picked for immediate action or more research. All agreed it was a very productive meeting and will net many positive results for Meadows Place.

This is a quick, simple and inexpensive fix which you can learn more about in the Code Enforcement article on page 4. There are several options, and any option that meets code is acceptable, but not meeting code will soon earn you a citation and nobody wants that. Code Enforcement has granted us a grace period, which is almost over, so don't put this off. Besides making the city look nicer, quickly identified addresses will make it a lot easier for first responders to find us in an emergency. Thank You in advance for your co-operation. Premises Identification/ aka: House Numbers

Beginning MONDAY JUNE 1st, 2015, warnings will be issued for not having address numbers visible to the front of your home or business. They can be placed on your home, painted on the curb, or on your mailbox. Beginning Wednesday July 1st, 2015, citations

will be issued for the homes that are not in compliance.

This is required by the Code because it is a **SAFETY ISSUE** that needs to taken seriously.

The **IPMC** (International Property Maintenance Code), is part of our Code of Ordinances that was adopted in 1984, and renewed by Council in 2014. This is what it says:

[F] 304.3 Premises identification.

Buildings shall have approved address numbers placed in a position to be plainly legible and visible from the street or road fronting the property. These numbers shall contrast with their background. Address numbers shall be Arabic numerals or alphabet letters. Numbers shall be a minimum of 4 inches (102 mm) in height with a minimum stroke width of 0.5 inch (12.7 mm).

Our City Ordinance further defines:

§ 153.197 SIGNS; RESIDENTIAL.

The following regulations shall apply for signs located on property in residential use or institutional use:

(A) Signs indicating only the name and/or address of the occupant shall be permitted for each residential unit;

§ 153.999 PENALTY.

(D) Any person who violates or causes, allows, or permits another to violated any provision of §§ 153.197 or 153.198 shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$2,000.

Fight the Bite! Reduce your Risk

As rainfalls continue to increase in the greater Fort Bend – Harris County area our concerns turn toward mosquitoes and our ability to enjoy the outdoors without being harassed by them. Always remember to protect yourself from mosquitoes

when you are outside in the early morning and the evening. Use spray that contains "Deet", wear long sleeves and long pants if you want to avoid being bitten. You also have an option of not going outside if you feel the mosquitoes are present in heavy numbers.

The City would like to remind residents to take precautions to clear away mosquito breeding areas around their homes. West Nile Virus (WNV), which surfaced in the U.S. more than ten years ago, is commonly transmitted back and forth between infected birds and mosquitoes. However, humans can become the unintended hosts of the disease when they are bitten by an infected mosquito.

Easy steps to take in any backyard to remove potential breeding grounds for mosquitos include eliminating standing water from the property, cleaning debris from rain gutters, changing bird bath water once a week, emptying and turning over containers that could collect water, and checking for trapped water in canvas or plastic tarps. Standing water is a potential breeding ground for mosquitoes. Anything that can hold water for four days can breed 1000s of mosquitoes. Eliminating standing water has proven effective in controlling WNV. Mosquitoes can also be kept out of the home by keeping windows, doors, and porches tightly screened. The City will continue to monitor bird baths and treat storm drains to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes.

Let's all enjoy the outdoors this summer and help stop the spread of mosquitoes!
