Safety Tips for Winter Heating



It's that time of year to start heating our homes again! Below are some safety tips you may want to consider before you start running your gas operating mechanical systems and appliances.

- Some of our homes still have the original gas valves that are spring loaded and outdated. These valves will eventually leak after time and should be pressure tested or even better, replace with a valve that is up to today's safety standards. Plumbers pull permits to replace these failing valves at a rate of twenty to thirty per year. You may want to consider replacing all of your valves!
- Clean and inspect your chimney for cracks, openings and make sure that the flue is in operating condition and is open before you start a fire. If you burn real wood in your fireplace you should clean your chimney at least once a year. Creosote can build up and ignite!
- Test your smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors.

Make your home safe for the fall season by following the tips above.
