### COMMENTS FROM THE MAYOR By Charles Jessup



#### Looking back at 2009

What a Year, and what a testimony to the tremendous staff we have. We saw a dry hot summer that tore up our streets and water pipes, an economy that took a tumble and the announcement of several major projects that will change the face of Meadows Place for years. With reduced crew we managed to see several small projects completed and increased maintenance. We converted our pool to saltwater, made physical

and technological enhancements at the Community Center and converted the old fire truck barn to a useable, money saving Parks facility. We had a new Code Enforcement Officer join our staff along with a financial specialist to strengthen our financial department. We are so fortunate to have a staff that cares to the degree that these folks do. I am continually impressed by their compassion and dedication.

In 2009 our Police Department shined as well. They managed to keep officers on the streets while operating with two officers short due to injury and surgery. They went to longer shifts and floating days off, and did it with a smile and a reassuring sense of duty. They covered a 5K fun run as well as special events and even helped out neighboring cities from time to time.

2009 had some unique and exciting challenges. Thanks to a strong City Staff, a Council that worked extra hard and a Police Department that continues to care, we were able to overcome these challenges and get quite a bit accomplished.

#### **Looking Forward**

2010 will be an interesting year. We will begin the Airport / Kirkwood Reconstruction project, revitalize the Waste Water Treatment Plant and begin construction on the Phase IV of the Parks and Wildlife Grant. With grant monies, we will build a Mobile Communications System for regional use and upgrade the audio video systems in our police cars. We will complete the codification of our ordinances and provide additional "green" savings through a significant reduction in electricity at City Hall. We will also work hard to provide the level of services that the residents of Meadows Place expect and deserve. Personally, I am looking forward to the challenges and opportunities 2010 will provide.

Other items of note are the meetings in January and the upcoming election. The first is on Jan. 14th at the Community Center for those interested serving on the MCIA board. The second will be held on the 19th where Council will hear opinions on possible changes to the Garage Sale policy. Then on May 19th the city will hold an election. The Mayors and three Council seats are up for reelection. Serving in City Government is not for everyone, but if you are interested, now would be the time to start attending Council and Workshop meetings to see if this is something you want to do and are willing to commit to. Check with City Hall for filing dates and requirements.

#### **Public Meeting Notice**

There will be a Public Meeting on Thursday, January 14th, 2010 at 7:00pm at the Community Center for all persons interested in serving on Meadows Place MCIA Board of Directors.

Council plans to reestablish the MCIA in the first quarter of 2010. Though most of the burden of protecting property values now lies with Code Enforcement, the enforcement and selection of choice of paint color and roofing can be strengthened through the reestablishment of the MCIA Board of Directors.

A maximum of Five (5) Board Members will be chosen by Council. The board President, who will serve as the sole liaison with the City, will be chosen by the board. The primary responsibility of the MCIA Board of Directors will be updating and maintaining a 'Book of Colors' at City Hall for citizens to use for paint selection. Among other things, they will meet on a regular basis and be available to any citizen that wishes to request a variance on paint color. MCIA Board members are also expected to cooperate with our Code Enforcement Officer and be additional "eyes and ears" for the City. The Mayor, the City Attorney, and Code Enforcement Officer will be at the meeting to explain what we need the MCIA Board to do, what we hope to accomplish and to answer any questions.

#### How do I get on the Board?

- 1. Prior to the Meeting you will need to leave your 'resume' at City Hall in an envelope marked MCIA. This 'resume' needs to contain your Name, Address, Contact information, and the reason why you wish to serve on this board along with any background or experience that you have that you feel would make you stand out to Council . Feel free to include references, etc.
- 2. Attend the Meeting. This is to ensure you understand the new role of the MCIA Board of Directors, the legal ramifications and limitations, what you can and cannot do, etc. It will also be a time for you to ask questions and give input.
- 3. Can I attend if I am not sure? Yes, but if you think you might want to be on the MCIA Board, be sure to hand in a 'resume' prior to the meeting. Then, if you change your mind, just let City Hall know.

## Did You Know?...

Did You Know....that our Police Department hosted a regional Legislative Update training program in the Community Center last month? Our technological updates now make it possible to have these type of training events here in Meadow Place, many of which are mandated by State and Federal regulatory bodies. Having them here in Meadows Place saves us a lot of time and money. Our Public Works Dept. has utilized these "new" facilities and of course the Parks Department programs were enhanced by the improvements as well. All you had to do was check the headcount on movie days during the summer to see that. A big thanks to Captain Jack Aston for doubling as the city's IT Director and overseeing projects like this for the City.

Speaking of our Police Department,

Did You Know....Meadows Place
PD is part of a group of Ft. Bend police departments that is working with Houston
PD Crime Analysts to develop a regional plan for crime prevention and information exchange?
They have a tough job but are working hard to stay one step ahead of the bad guys. We can do our part by not leaving "goodies" in our cars, by calling them when something looks out of the ordinary and by just giving them a smile and a wave as they pass by.

**Did You Know**....that the Dulles Middle School Symphony Orchestra was selected as a Commended Winner in the 2009 Mark of Excellence Program and were also selected to perform and compete at the 63rd Annual Midwest Clinic in Chicago where they will compete on an international level? Just another example of the outstanding opportunities Meadows Place students enjoy.

**Did You Know**....that preliminary lab results indicate that we will be able to use the treated water out of our Waste Water Treatment Plant to fill the new lake at the park and then use that water to irrigate the park and esplanades? By "Going Green", we will also be able to save ourselves Subsidence Fees on the 9 to 10 million gallons of water it takes to run our plant. In a

related item, we have begun refurbishing our Waste Water Treatment Plant to get it ready for the "greywater" addition. This will make the plant much more efficient and, when complete, should save us somewhere between 20,000 to 25,000 dollars annually on electrical costs alone! We hope to have the entire project completed by this time next year, if not sooner. Almost all, if not all of this will be paid for from existing bond funds and will save the city a ton in the long run. We will keep you posted.

Mayor was part of a panel of Mayors that made themselves available to the 2009 Ft. Bend Chamber of Commerce Leadership Forum? They answered questions ranging from transportation to taxes to help the participants as they learn to fill the ever increasing need for volunteer leadership in Fort Bend County. This is a great program and was an opportunity to see what was on the minds of these involved citizens and hear how our neighboring cities are addressing the problems facing us today.

Did You Know....that Meadows Place really had some nice lights out this year? Some of the displays were simply amazing. Thanks to everyone for making this Holiday season so special and thanks to our Parks and Public Works Depts. for putting up the holiday displays around the city. But, next year we need to talk to our youngsters about the cost of pulling pranks around the city. Seems some of the kids thought it was funny to pull the bulbs out of some of the lights around the park. We ended up taking down a number of strings of lights over the archways and out of the trees. We had a lot of our tax money invested in time and materials that just went to waste. Parents, please talk to your children about taking pride in the City so Meadows Place can continue to be... Did you know that having records of your personal property can be one of the biggest assets to the police in solving a crime? Do you have a list of the serial numbers of your personal property? If so this information can be provided to police officers immediately upon the report of a crime and can be entered into several national computer data bases.

We encourage you to make a list of your personal property including computers, computer games, audio/video electronics, tools, bicycles, watches and firearms. Include in this list the brand name, model number, serial number, and any unique identifying marks on the item. For property that does not have any exclusive numbers, engrave your driver's license number on the item.

Also, for property such as jewelry, take photographs so that we can make comparisons to bracelets, necklaces, and rings we find in pawn shops. Having the photograph is extremely helpful for us in searching through lists of items that are bought by pawn shops in the Houston and Southeast Texas area.

Upon receipt of the description and serial numbers, officers of the Meadows Place Police Department enter these items into a national data base. This provides immediate access for any police officer nationwide to assist us in recovering your stolen property.

Our agency also has a national pawn shop database which we can search for property by serial number or description. When an item is presented at a pawn shop the information from the property is entered into the data base and if the serial numbers match we are immediately notified.

Providing us this information is an important tool which we can use to help recover your valuable property. We are working together with you to make our city a safer and better place to live.



## **Public Meeting Notice**

There will be a Public Meeting on Tuesday, January 19th, 2010 at 7:00pm at City Hall to discuss a possible amendment to the City of Meadows Place Garage Sale Ordinance.

As there has been much discussion regarding the number of Garage Sales allowed in Meadows Place, as well as the number of Garage Sales an individual may have, City Council has endorsed having a Public Meeting on Garage Sales as the best method with which to allow public discourse and input regarding garage sales.

This is a Public Meeting only. No action will be taken. However, input from this hearing may or may not cause Council to seek to amend the current Garage Sale ordinance. Please attend if you wish to express your views.

#### **Probable Garage Sale Discussion Options**

As part of the Public Meeting, a poll will be taken on the following options as a guide for Council.

- 1. No Change in existing ordinance. This leaves us with a total of six Garage Sales a year allowing an individual to only have two (2) per year. Permit required.
- 2. Amend Ordinance to allow a total of Four (4) Garage Sales per year but allowing an individual to participate in all four (4) if they so choose. Permit required.
- 3. Amend Ordinance to allow Zero (0) garage sales per year.







#### **Types of Storm Water Pollution**

Meadows Place, as well as every city and utility in the nation are required by their state agencies, in our case the state agency would be Texas Commission on Environmental

Quality (TCEQ), to comply with rules and regulations set by each state for storm water management.

Meadows Place is in year three of its Storm Water Management Plan (MS4). Our storm water system will see yearly inspections on:

- Storm drains stenciling program
- The quality of runoff from the city
- Public education and outreach efforts
- Records of citations, fines, and other compliance documentations.

Public Works Staff as well Code-Enforcement are managing the Storm Water Management Plan, responding to reports of illegal dumping, making a report, giving out warnings and in some cases writing citations to violators.

Intentionally pouring pollutants and dumping debris into street gutters and storm drains is dangerous to the environment, and it is also illegal and carries a fine plus the cost of cleaning and removing the contaminates.

#### **Three Types of Storm Water Pollution**

Storm water pollution can be split into three general classifications

- 1. Litter cigarette butts, cans, food wrappers, plastic bags, paper, solid debris and especially news papers that are not picked up.
- 2. Natural Pollution leaves, yard clippings, soils or animal feces.
- 3. Chemical Pollution fertilizers, oil, paint, gasoline, detergent, overflowing sewers or any other liquid except clean water.

With help from the public we can keep the water of our city and the state clean and keep rain water flowing during rain events.



The 20th annual Meadows Place Christmas Memories in the Park took place on Friday, December 11th. This yearly event is a favorite tradition among residents and visitors!







The highlight of the evening is always the arrival of Santa. This year,


