#### Taxing Times

These are trying times. The City of Meadows Place is being affected by what has been a dismal economy. The past couple of years have seen the collapse of basic industries, a strained financial system, foreclosures at a rate not seen since the depression and cities across the country selling premier property and assets just to reduce fiscal responsibilities in an attempt

to shed debt. Meadows Place has been stung by this terrible downturn as well. Fortunately, your city leaders got together last year and, anticipating this continued downturn, made what were considered by some to be draconian cuts. Hindsight proves they were reasonable, justified and timely.

Last year I learned a new word – diminimus – which many of you will know, means a difference too small to make an impact. Or, something too small to bother with. Well, we bothered. Last year we scrutinized every single line item and, driven by anticipated declines in revenue, did it again this year. This year however, there wasn't much left to cut before we got to trimming programs and services. Through hard work by Staff and Council, we were able to strike a balance and came up with a plan, and a budget, that will allow us to enjoy both the services and safety we are used to. But make no bones about it, it's going to be tough.

#### Strengthening our Reserves

We are going to take in less money than we did this last year, but we are also spending less. Revenues are down again but it is important to note that this budget does not increase our debt. In fact, we are reducing our debt a little and in order to protect you and protect the financial integrity of the City are NOT dipping into our reserves like many cities are. The following is a comparison of this budget year to last. You can go online to look at the details but for your convenience we put a summary of the totals.

## Tax Rate Changing

The bottom line is this - your taxes and the amount you pay will be changing this year. How much you actually pay, and which way it will go, is decided by values set by the Central Appraisal District in conjunction with the tax rate adopted by your City Council. Last years tax rate was .83 per \$100.00 of valuation. This year the rate is .895 per \$100.00 of valuation. This means a home valued at \$120,000 both last year and this year will see an increase of \$78.00 or \$6.50 a month. This rate is actually a little less than the "effective" rate and is significantly less than the "Rollback" rate of \$.979 - which is what Council could have raised it to. Everyone agreed times were too tenuous to even consider that. This was another tough budget year which raised a lot of questions by Staff and Council as we went through the budget process. Tdentity Theft is a crime. Unfortunately, it is one of the ■ fastest growing crimes in America, and is a crime that affects us here in Meadows Place. When people find themselves victims of identity theft most have no idea how the thief acquired their personal information. If you become a victim of identity theft the consequences can be overwhelming. Thieves can target you by opening bank or credit accounts and can access your credit card and bank account numbers, make large charges and create counterfeit checks. Those individuals involved in identity theft have become very creative in their ways to gain your personal information. Many times people don't know they have been a victim until they are notified by a collection company or law enforcement agency. Although there is no way to completely prevent yourself from becoming a victim, there are some steps you can take to guard yourself from identity theft.

Keep your personal information safe. Don't keep Personal Identification Numbers (PINs) near your checkbook, ATM card or debit card. Shred any papers with any confidential information before you discard them. This includes junk mail, credit card offers or anything with any type of account information, receipts, bank statements, expired credit cards, doctor bills, and insurance documents.

Be careful where you put your purse or wallet. Many thieves target shopping malls and stores looking for unattended purses or wallets. Keep your purse closed and fastened, if possible. A thief can reach inside an open purse and remove a wallet quickly and you may not notice it until you reach the checkout.

Beware of any phone calls or emails requesting personal information. Unless you have initiated the contact don't give out any of your information, such as your birth date, social security number, PINs, or any codeword such as your mother's maiden name that might be used as security question to gain access to your accounts. Never answer phishing emails. If your receive one of these and it directs you to a link for the company, do not use this link. Contact your bank directly through their website or by phone.

Monitor your bank, credit statements and credit reports on a regular basis. Be on guard for identity theft. If you find yourself the victim of Identity theft or fraudulent activity contact the Police Department.

#### Junked Vehicles

I would assume that the image that pops into a person's mind when I mention the term "Junked Vehicle" would be that of an old rusty car or truck that is missing several pieces. It possibly conjures up

the image of a vehicle that has obviously seen better days, and is headed for the scrap heap.

Well the term "Junked Vehicle", as defined in our code of ordinances, is actually any vehicle that is self-propelled and:

1.) does not have lawfully attached to it both an unexpired license plate, including annual registrations certificate, and a valid motor vehicle inspection certificate issued by the proper authority under the laws of the State of Texas;

#### OR


2.) Is wrecked, dismantled or partially dismantled or discarded; or has remained inoperable and not moved from the property upon which it has been parked for more than thirty (30) consecutive days. Movement shall not be deemed to have occurred unless said vehicle is operated upon a public street of the City of Meadows Place for a distance of at least five (5) miles, displaying a valid license numbered plate, registration certificate and a valid Texas inspection sticker.

Junked vehicles which are located in any place where they are visible from a public place or public right-of-way are declared to be detrimental to the safety and welfare of the general public. Such junked vehicles tend to reduce the value of property, to invite vandalism, to create fire hazards, to constitute an attractive nuisance creating a hazard to the health and safety of minors, and are detrimental to the economic welfare of the City by producing urban blight which is adverse to the maintenance and continuing development of the City.

So just to sum things up; a vehicle that isn't registered or doesn't carry a current inspection (even when parked in your driveway) is not allowed within our city. To be driveway legal, the vehicle needs to be street legal.






