# COMMENTS FROM THE MAYOR By Mark McGrath

## TORNADO DAMAGE

On November 17th around noon, a tornado swept through our City. After doing damage in Sugar Land, the tornado entered the City near the corner of Dairy Ashford and West Airport. From there, it proceeded roughly on a line and exited the City near the intersection of Amblewood and Monticeto. From there, it proceeded on to the City of Houston, doing significant damage to apartment complexes at the corner of South Kirkwood and West Bellfort.

Besides the damaged roofs, broken limbs and downed fences suffered by many residents and Meadows Elementary School, City facilities were also impacted. Remnants of a roof blown off a house on Monticeto landed on the City's sewage treatment plant. A power line snapped as a result and the plant was shut down for several hours. Fortunately, public health was not threatened during this time.

However, the control structure next to the plant suffered roof damage as did the electrical panel inside. The fence around the plant was also damaged as was some of the mechanical equipment inside. City reserve funds will pay for the cost of fixing these items. Insurance proceeds and other sources will be pursued to minimize the impact of the storm on the City's budget.

Public safety personnel were deployed immediately after the touchdown. Your Public Works Department cleared storm drains and other areas of debris in the ensuing downpour and coordinated the effort to remove debris from the streets and right-of-way. Your Police Department was present throughout the afternoon and into the evening, checking on the welfare of residents and property as well as directing traffic around the affected areas. The Stafford Volunteer Fire Department was present to assist in helping individuals and securing property. The Stafford Police Department provided officers to assist ours. The County Road and Bridge Department provided crews and equipment on a moment's notice to remove debris, both that afternoon, and also in the following days. The Fort Bend ISD police were present at Meadows Elementary School to help direct traffic in the wake of concerned parents coming to the school to check on the welfare of their children.

As you can see, this was a professional, collaborative effort to respond to an emergency situation. I think we can be pleased with the level of effort demonstrated and the quick response. If this situation should occur again in the future, and I hope it doesn't, it is good to know we have professionals such as these available to respond.

#### **ALARM PERMITS**

All alarm permits expire December 31<sup>st</sup>. Alarm permits are renewable for \$5.00. Any permit that is not renewed by December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2003 will be deemed cancelled.

Cancelled permits shall not be renewable and must be reapplied for at the initial fee of \$15.00. Alarm permits are required by City Ordinance. Failure to comply may result in the issuance of a citation by Meadows Place Police Department. When renewing your permit by mail, your cancelled check will be your receipt.

#### GARAGE SALE DATES

Garage sales are limited to the last weekend of odd numbered months (January, March, May, etc.) Weekends are defined as Friday and Saturday. Residents may have up to 2 garage sales per year on the designated weekends. A garage sale permit is required. Please refer to the dates show below for garage sale dates.

### WATER LEAKS AND SEWER STOPPAGES

If you experience a water leak or sewer stoppage at your residence, call ECO Resources at 281-240-1300 **BEFORE** calling a plumber, unless you are absolutely positive the leak or stoppage is your responsibility. An operator from ECO will come to your home, diagnose the problem and notify you whether or not you will need a plumber to correct the problem. If the problem is occurring in the City owned main or house line tap on the main, it will be rectified. If you call a plumber first and the problem turns out to be the responsibility of the City, you will not be reimbursed for the cost of the plumber.


