The committee recommendations were: 4 in favor of allowing laying hens in Meadows Place; 1 against; and 1 in favor of the city not addressing the issue at all since deed restrictions currently cover the topic. The recommendations to Council included several restrictions as well.

Council is seeking additional legal opinion and will have additional input prior to the February workshop deliberations. As we have learned, the Urban Chicken discussion is taking place throughout the US and Canada with as many different options as there are cities. Whether City Council creates an ordinance to allow laying hens, prohibits laying hens or takes no action at this time, Meadows Place is now part of the national Urban Chicken debate. It is amazing what all takes place in our little one square mile city...

Hike and Bike Trails

The City of Meadows Place was instrumental in helping State Representative Rick Miller and CenterPoint Energy come together to craft a bill which will allow CenterPoint to work with governing agencies like us to install Hike and Bike Trails on their easement and Right of Ways in Fort Bend County. We are in hopes that Representative Miller's bill passes so we may expand our trail network. Thank You Representative Miller.

COLD WEATHER SAFETY TIPS

As temperatures start to drop in January, February, and March. We must all be prepared to deal with the possibility of temperatures dropping below the freezing level. In the greater Houston area, the weather changes constantly and we can easily find ourselves unprepared to deal with a sudden freeze. Here are a few precautions we should be ready to deal with and prepared for;

1. Bring in pets: Pets should never be left out in the cold for extended periods of time. Pets can get frostbite on their ear tips, noses, tails and paws. Make sure your pets have a warm place to sleep.


2. Wrap your outside pipes and faucets: Pipes should be wrapped to protect against possible water pipes freezing and cracking. Water pipe failures can lead to high water bills, and expensive plumbing repairs. Be sure to take precautions and wrap your pipes!

3. Wrap your plants: Be sure to place a cloth or plastic over your plants to protect them from wind chills and icy weather. Most plants will survive if precautions are taken.

4. People: If you have to go out in cold and freezing weather be sure to avoid hazardous conditions. Stay off of icy roads and bridges if you have to be on the road. Watch for ice on sidewalks (walk carefully), driveways, and streets. Dress appropriately!

Remember to check on the elderly and those who may have functional needs, or access needs, to make sure that they have sufficient warmth to get them through the cold weather. Also, if you, or someone you know, uses space heaters or a fireplace, make sure there is at least 3 feet of empty space around them while they are being operated.



Mailbox Month

March is MAILBOX MONTH here in the City of Meadows Place! This March is the 8th anniversary of this event for our City. Mailbox Month is the time we take a look at the first impression of your home & see what needs to be repaired or replaced, and will result in a **\$10 discount** on your water bill!

Mailboxes are typically constructed to last about 10 years, depending on the materials used, and the USPS states that it is the homeowner's responsibility to maintain and replace worn or damaged mailboxes. If it has been quite a while since you have replaced yours, take an objective look at it.

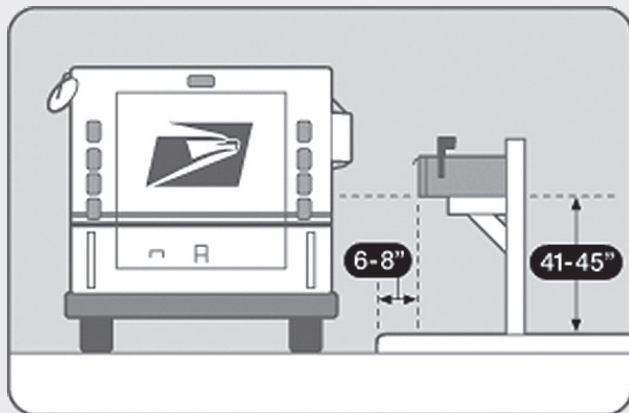
HOW TO PARTICIPATE: Through the month of March; mail, place in the Utilities Billing Box or e-mail (code-enforcement@cityofmeadowsplace.org) a "before" and "after" photo of your newly rejuvenated or replaced mailbox to City Hall. **Each participating residence will receive a \$10 discount off of their water utility bill!**

Some mailboxes only need fresh paint or minor maintenance like painting, rust removal, up-righting the post, etc., while other may need to be replaced altogether. Hardware stores like Lowes, Home Depot, and Court's Hardware sell reasonably priced replacements, and with a modest amount of effort you will have a fresh new look!

CURBSIDE MAILBOX STANDARDS:

- The bottom of the mailbox should be located between 41 - 45 inches in height from the surface of the curb.
- The name and address on your mailbox should be at least 1 inch letters/numbers.
- The front of your mailbox door should be located 6 - 8 inches from the front face of the curb.

Please contact our local post office if you are considering moving the location of your mailbox.

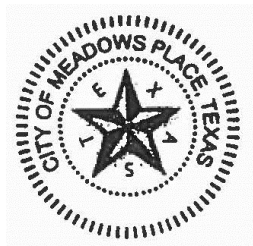

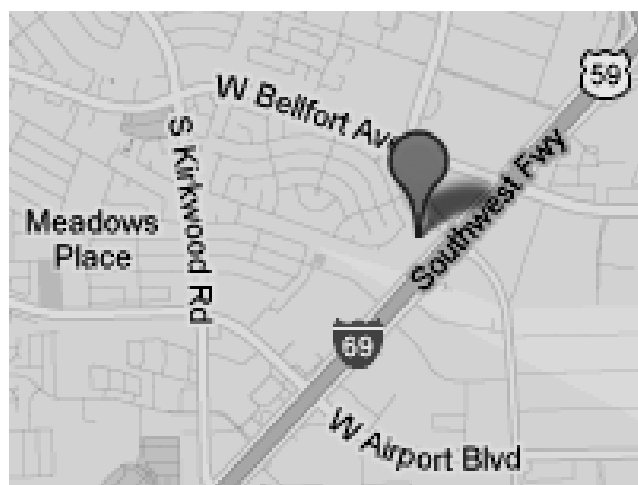
