### *Census Report – and Request*

Census 2020 is very important to Meadows Place. If we prove a 5,000 population it means Meadows Place can vote on whether or not we want to go Home Rule or remain a Type A General Law city. The big difference is Home Rule cities do what they want to do and General Law cities

do what the State tells them to do. The latest figures I found have Meadows Place at 68.5%. Though higher than the County average, this is simply not going to get us to the 5,000 people it takes to be able to vote on whether or not Meadows Place will become a Home Rule City. I believe we need to be around the 90% mark to do that. A low census turnout does not help the Meadows Place, Fort Bend County or the State of Texas. Right now Texas is sitting at 48.52% and Fort Bend County's is at 56.6%. The paper copies of the Census Form should have recently reached each house that did not complete the online forms. If returned, this means we should see a big jump across the State and I am hoping to see a bump in Meadows Place numbers as well. If you have not completed your Census Form, please do so immediately. If you do not have your Census ID number, have not received the paper form or just need a little help, check out the CENSUS section on our website or call Census 2020 at 844-330-2020.


### **CARES**

Meadows Place has chosen our City Administrator, Nick Haby, to be our representative on the CARES Distribution Advisory Panel. CARES stands for Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, also known as the CARES Act. # Did You Know?...

**Did You Know...** Texas Hydrant Services water blasted and painted 142 fire hydrants here in Meadows Place. This followed testing, repairs and maintenance on all our hydrants within the last couple of months. I don't know about you, but if those Fire Fighters pull up to a hydrant I want them to be able to get all the water they need!...Ongoing maintenance projects like this will keep the city functioning at a high level and make sure Meadows Place stays *--Your Place for Life!*

**Did You Know...** Josh Merritt founder of Josh Merritt Creative, flew his photo drone over the Meadows school construction site last month. He will do two more flyovers as part of the Meadows Elementary construction Time Lapse compilation that the Meadows Place Economic Development Corporation is funding. This should be fun for everyone and a good tool for our EDC to use to recruit new businesses. Josh is also doing a historic photo array-with drone shots-on the Kirkwood project. Thank You, Josh. **Did You Know...** The City of Meadows Place has two alert and information programs you definitely be signed up for. One is our CodeRED - Emergency & Alert System<sup>®</sup> used by The City of Meadows Place to distribute information and emergency alerts. The other is our EyeOnWater program that lets you monitor your water usage. You can even see hourly water usage and set an alert in case you have a leak. Very helpful. Sign up on our website or call City Hall if you have questions. .

**Did You Know...** I had someone contact me who had taken a fall while walking. She asked about sidewalks and wanted to know if they were a priority in Meadows Place. I was thrilled to tell her that for the last budget year your City Council voted unanimously to more than double funding for sidewalk repair. This meant almost 2½ times the amount of sidewalk repaired or replaced this fiscal year. Most of which has been done. We

created a plan so if you will send us an address, our Public Works Director, Erik Tschanz, will come by, evaluate and document the location and put it on the list for repair sometime in the future. FYI - Moving forward, even in these uncertain times, I am going to urge Council to keep the current level of sidewalk funding and not cut it back. I think we can do that.

**Did You Know...** I received some feedback on the Bamboo article in last month's Did You Know. Seems we do have some people who put that invasive bamboo in their yards. Caldwell Nursery is the best I know in dealing with bad bamboo and what to put in instead of that horribly invasive runner type bamboo.

Texas will be sending the funds to the counties for COVID19 reimbursement to cities and other jurisdictions. I am proud to say that Meadows Place will have a seat at the table and thanks to our efforts, many other small cities in Fort Bend will too. Nick, who has experience with disaster recovery allocations, will be making sure Meadows Place gets as much of the reimbursable COVID costs as possible. This pool of money, some \$141 million dollars, will be split up between several types of jurisdictions and Meadows Place, through Nick, will be helping to decide the allocation mechanism. Going the extra mile and participating in programs for the future will help ensure Meadows Place will continue to be... **Your Place for Life!**

### City Election

for the Prevention of COVID-19**


**T**here is currently no vaccine to prevent COVID-19. The best way to prevent infection is to take steps to avoid exposure to this virus, which are similar to the steps you take to avoid the flu.




- *Wash hands with soap and water.*



- *Use hand sanitizer as backup.*



- *Cover coughs and sneezes.*



- *Avoid touching face.*



- *Disinfect often touched surfaces.*



- *Practice Social Distancing. Keep at least six feet away from others.*

DSHS recommends these everyday actions to help prevent the spread of any respiratory virus, including COVID-19:

- Wash hands often for 20 seconds and encourage others to do the same.
- If no soap and water are available, use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- Cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue, then throw the tissue away.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Disinfect surfaces, buttons, handles, knobs, and other places touched often.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.

DSHS also recommends that you start practicing social distancing. Social distancing involves staying away from other people to avoid catching or spreading illness. It's a fancy term for avoiding crowds and minimizing physical contact. This could mean avoiding concerts or weddings, skipping the handshake, and/or staying at least six feet away from others.

## Code Enforcement

May Flowers are blooming In Meadows Place! We are always striving to maintain our 1 square mile of wonderful. I believe this is partly because as a community we stand together to do the right thing to ensure each other's safety and protect our property values. The following was published in our Newsletter 15 years ago showing standards held by previous leadership - which still hold true today. Assist your neighbors by:

- Cleaning mildew/mold from wood, brick, siding and eaves.
- Make sure trash cans are placed behind your fence, garage, or house. (cans should not be visible from the streets on non-pickup days)
- Keeping trash, empty pots, old newspapers, and discarded items picked up and out of sight
- Tree stumps must be ground down to ground level. So that grass can grow over the area where the tree had been.

## Fire Hydrant / Valve Painting



Recently the City of Meadows Place Public Works department contracted with Texas Hydrant Services to paint the City's 142 fire hydrants. Texas Hydrant Services from Baytown, Texas has painted numerous hydrants for other municipalities such as City of Spring Valley Village, City of Bellaire as well as many other Municipal Utility Districts (MUD'S) surrounding the Houston Metro-Plex. The project began early this past March and in just a little over one month the job was completed. In addition to getting the fire hydrants painted our own USW utility group personnel painted hundreds of both hydrant valve and water main valve covers throughout the city dark blue. Some of you may have noticed these improvements recently. This is just one example of infrastructure improvements being made here within Meadows Place from the Public Works department.

## LIFEGUARDS & SWIM INSTRUCTORS


The City of Meadows Place is accepting applications for Summer 2020. Applications can be picked up and turned in at City of Meadows Place City Hall or Nature & Discovery Center @ 11938 Amblerwood Dr. in the drop box located beside the front door. Must be 15 years of age.

If applying for the lifeguard/gate attendant position, you must pass the prerequisite requirements, and be available for a 3-day lifeguard course to be announced.

**Prerequisites:** Minimum age: 15 years; Swim 300 yards continuously; Tread water for 2 minutes using only the legs; Complete a timed event within 1 minute, 40 seconds by starting in the water, swimming 20 yards, surface dive to a depth of 7 to 10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object, return to the surface and swim 20 yards on the back to return to the starting point, exit without using steps or ladder.
