Meadows Place has a reputation as being a place that votes...well, we didn't this time, and as a small, one square mile community, we need to. This election there were Approx. 201 MP ballots cast). We have a 'new' county commissioner and he, the other commissioners and County Judge will all be looking to see which areas vote, and which do not. This is

important. We very much need to be known as an area that votes. This is noted by state and national representatives as well and our participation levels will play a role in the support we get. The County had a 6.6% overall turnout, Meadows Place came in at 9.55% with 310 of our 3245 registered voters turning out. Mosquitos...

Although about 95% of the city belongs to homeowners, the City of Meadows Place conducts an ongoing mosquito spraying program annual to try to limit risk of getting bit by those pesky mosquitos. We also put mosquito pucks in our storm drains to prevent mosquito larvae growth. This means that most of the mosquitos being bred today are most likely coming from our yards, gutters, toys that have a little water in them, stagnant pools, etc. Mosquitoes love moisture, so if you have excess water anywhere in your yard, they'll be attracted to it.

Like all other areas near the Gulf Coast, Meadows Place is subject to attack by several types of mosquitos. Most are just an irritant, however some bites carry a health risk. The most prominent are the West Nile and Zeka viruses.

While most people who get infected with West Nile virus do not have any symptoms about 1 out of 150 infected people develop a serious, sometimes fatal, illness. One person I know got West Nile, almost died, was bedridden for weeks and took about eight months to recover enough to get around. Extreme, maybe, but not to her. West Nile can be very bad.

The Zika virus is also a risk and has the potential to have an even larger impact in 2023. The Zika virus is spread by the bite of an infected Aedes species mosquito. These mosquitos breed in artificial containers such as gutters that have not been cleared, potted plant saucers, and other areas holding stagnant water. To help in the fight against Zika and other mosquito borne diseases, homeowners should carefully inspect their yards for these types of conducive conditions and get rid of ANY standing water. Fireworks Prohibited in the City of Meadows Place

In an effort to maintain a desirable and peaceful community, the City of Meadows place has banned the discharge of fireworks within the city limits. As we approach the Fourth of July the Meadows Place Police Department hopes everyone has a great holiday and to remind all; Fireworks are not allowed in the City of Meadows Place (at any time), violators are subject to be cited and incurring up to a \$500 fine.

City of Meadows Place City Ordinance:

§ 130.35 FIREWORKS.

(A) Definitions. For the purpose of this section, the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

FIREWORKS. The term shall include **FIREWORKS**, firecrackers, rockets, sparklers, torpedoes, Roman candles, fire balloons and all other substances or any combination whatsoever designed or intended to produce a noise or effects of fireworks or pyrotechnics, whether or not herein specifically designated and defined.

SET OFF. This term shall include setting off, firing, igniting, discharging or in any other manner setting into action, and shall also include the causing of any of such things to happen.

(B) Prohibitions. It shall be unlawful to manufacture, store, sell, possess or set off fireworks within the city

PENALITY. Any person who violates or causes, allows or permits another to violated any provision of § 130.35 shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500. Each occurrence of any violation of § 130.35 shall constitute a separate offense. Each day on which any such violation of § 130.35 occurs shall constitute a separate offense.

If you observe a Fireworks violation, please contact the Meadows Place Police Department 281-983-2900. If calling after hours, ask for a Meadows Place Police Department officer.

Controlling Mosquitos Around Your Home

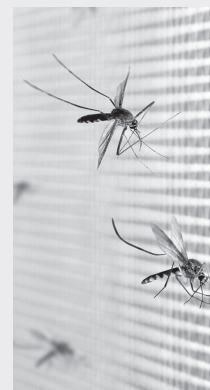
The City of Meadows Place currently sprays mosquitoes on a weekly basis. With the dry weather and almost complete lack of rain, the standing water has not been a major issue. When we return to a wet weather rain cycle, please be vigilant about removing standing water in your yard.

Mosquitoes range from being a nuisance to carriers of diseases such as malaria, West Nile Zika, and more. There are many ways to get rid of mosquitos, but they are not all equally effective. Personal chemical repellents include DEET, but most people would rather use a natural repellent with the use of essential oil sprays.

In the yard you can use yellow lights, burn Citronella candles, use a Thermacell, use Cedar mulch in the flower beds, consider a bug Zapper, keep your yard trim, and tidy, (Mosquitos love long grass and rest in dark, humid places). Set mosquito traps, eliminate standing water, attract natural predators like purple martins, swallows, and migratory songbirds to name a few. Consider natural plant deterrents, the following flora can

help keep the pers away. Lavender, Marigolds, Citronella, Catnip, Garlic, Peppermint, Rosemary, Geraniums, and sage.

Eliminating the resting places around the yard and keeping the grass trimmed is half of the battle. Killing them on the ground can be accomplished with the use of a spray application of herbicide that can be readily purchased at the local hardware store, this will interrupt the growth cycle of the pests.



Mosquitos lay a hundred eggs at a time so populations of this pest can get out of control quickly. When eliminating mosquitos, it is key to use multiple methods, since not all approaches kill mosquitos at every stage of the life cycle. The City will continue to spray mosquito control until the cooler weather is upon us. When the nighttime temperatures are below 70 degrees, these pests start to go dormant. High winds also affect the spraying for mosquitos.

If your mosquito problem is too serious to tackle on your own, hire a professional pest control company to banish the bloodsuckers.

Swimming Pools



Swimming Pools -Unsanitary/ State of Disrepair/ Mosquito Treatment Needed.

IPMC 303.1 Swimming Pools:

Swimming pools SHALL be maintained in a clean, sanitary condition, and in good repair

This is a straightforward code that all pool owners must ensure they follow. Failing to comply will result in a citation being issued. Code Enforcement will move quickly to abate this health hazard by ensuring the pool is cleaned if it is dirty or removed and filled-in if it is not in good repair(floating) by the home owner promptly.

3 Important Reminders:

1. If your pool is not maintained in a clean, sanitary condition and not in good repair it is not in compliance. Do so now. If you know of a pool not in compliance, I urge you to let me know right away via email at code-enforcement@cityofmeadowsplace.org.

It is a health hazard to allow a breeding ground for mosquitos and endangering the health of the community. The most active time for mosquitos are during the summer months of June, July, and August. However, mosquitos lay hundreds of eggs in as little as ¼" of water. Ensure all standing water is removed from your property and keep your pools maintained for your health and the health of the community.

2. Number of Cats and Dogs Limited 90.06(A).

It shall be unlawful for any person to keep, harbor, possess, maintain or allow to be kept, harbored, possessed or maintained more than four dogs or four cats or a combination of such animals with the total number not exceeding four, over four months old, upon or within any premises owned, occupied or under the control of the person within the city.

3. When submitting an anonymous complaint online; keep in mind that sometimes what you are submitting may not qualify as a violation. Repeated anonymous submissions do not allow me to address, with the complainant, more details about their concern. Contact information does not have to include a name; a phone Scan the QR Code below for more information on mosquito born illnesses that you can help put a stop to by keeping your pool clean and removing all standing water on your property.

During April 25, 2023, through May 15, 2023, there were a total of **159** Violations, **219** Notices issued, and **260** inspections completed. The following are the top **5** items that needed the most attention during this period.

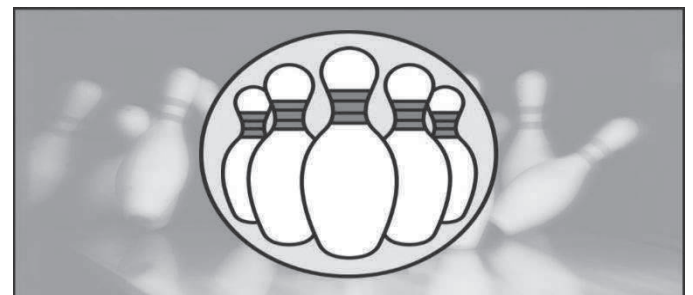
Our court will be under construction soon. We will be adding 2 permanent pickleball courts. In the meantime, we have temporary nets for you to try it out and see what all the fun is about.
