# **Controlling Mosquitos Around Your Home**

The City of Meadows Place currently sprays mosquitoes on a weekly basis. With the dry weather and almost complete lack of rain, the standing water has not been a major issue. When we return to a

wet weather rain cycle, please be vigilant about removing standing water in your yard.

Mosquitoes range from being a nuisance to carriers of diseases such as malaria, West Nile Zika, and more. There are many ways to get rid of mosquitos, but they are not all equally effective. Personal chemical repellents include DEET, but most people would rather use a natural repellant with the use of essential oil sprays.

In the yard you can use yellow lights, burn Citronella candles, use a Thermacell, use Cedar mulch in the flower beds, consider a bug Zapper, keep your yard trim, and tidy, (Mosquitos love long grass and rest in dark, humid places). Set mosquito traps, eliminate standing water, attract natural predators like purple martins, swallows, and migratory songbirds to name a few.

Consider natural plant deterrents, the following flora can

help keep the pers away. Lavender, Marigolds, Citronella, Catnip, Garlic, Peppermint, Rosemary, Geraniums, and sage.

By eliminating the resting places around the yard and keeping the grass trimmed is half of the battle. Killing them on the ground can be accomplished with the use of a spray application of herbicide that can be readily purchased at the local hardware store, this will interrupt the growth cycle of the pests.



Mosquitos lay a hundred eggs at a time so populations of this pest can get out of control quickly. When eliminating mosquitos, it is key to use multiple methods, since not all approaches kill mosquitos at every stage of the life cycle. The City will continue to spray mosquito control until the cooler weather is upon us. When the nighttime temperatures are below 70 degrees, these pests start to go dormant. High winds also affect the spraying for mosquitos.

If your mosquito problem is too serious to tackle on your own, hire a professional pest control company to banish the bloodsuckers.



As your new Code Enforcement Official with the City of Meadows Place, my goal is to work day in and day out with you, the citizen's of Meadows Place. However I will need your assistance in keeping Meadows Place "Your Place for Life!"

Please remember that there are some simple and impactful things we all can do to help keep our city attractive not just for our visitors, but most especially for ourselves:

- 1. Sec. 130.07(B) —It is unlawful for anyone to maintain trees, shrubs or other vegetative material upon a public street and/or public right-of-way less than the minimum clearance measured from the pavement to the lowest limb, branch or part thereof extending over the sidewalk and over the public street/pavement (Sidewalk: not less than 10 feet and Public Street: not less than 16 feet). Please remember to keep trees cut and trimmed.
- 2. Sec. 91.039(A) —It shall be unlawful for any person who shall own or occupy any lot or lots in the City to allow weeds/or grass to grow on the lot or lots to a height of more than nine (9) inches. At all times, please remember to keep lawns cut and trimmed.

3. Sec. 150.66 – Replacement of dead, dying or diseased landscaping materials. In the event the building official determines that any required vegetative landscaping material has died, is dying or is so badly diseased that the same cannot be saved or otherwise rehabilitated, the building official may direct the property owner being in control of the street yard to replace the dead, dying or diseased vegetative materials with like or similar replacement materials. Please make sure to maintain trees and landscaping.






