## Meadows Place City Council Budget Retreat and Workshop

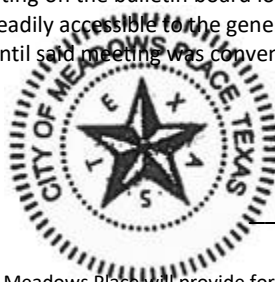
