AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MEADOWS PLACE, TEXAS, REPEALING CHAPTER 115 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED "FOOD SERVICE" IN ITS ENTIRETY AND

ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 115 ENTITLED "FOOD SERVICE"; PROVIDING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR FOOD SERVICE SANITATION AND PERMITTING; PROVIDING A PENALTY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
