#### Kirkwood Contract Signed

The City of Meadows Place has signed a construction contract with Mar-Con Construction to replace South Kirkwood Blvd. from the fire station down to the driveway of Sugar Grove Church. Weather permitting, the construction is slated to begin on January 2nd, 2019 and will take the better part of a year, and

Yes, it will be a mess. All construction projects are. We learned that from Airport. This project is the final phase of the Meadows Place portion of a Fort Bend Mobility Bond Project. It is a city/county project with County Mobility bonds picking up the majority of the project. Council unanimously approved the contract, the engineering is complete, the pre-construction meeting has taken place and now the start-up preparation is being done. Thanks go out to HDR Engineering, Asukura-Robinson and all the city staff who have worked so hard to make this happen on our end.

There was a project update at the Nov. 27th Council Meeting and there will be another opportunity for you to ask questions at the end of the Council Meeting on Dec. 18th. In about a month, we will be reminding everyone of construction start up using Code Red, the City website and the official City of Meadows Place Facebook page . Yes, it will be a mess, but when it is done, it the new Kirkwood thoroughfare will be safer, more beautiful, something that separates us from Alief and says you are now in Meadows Place... *Your Place for Life*. Happy Holidays everyone.

Where we are now is waiting for the School District to take all the ideas generated from the Rebuild Meadows Elementary Vison Session, compile them into a "workable solution" and then call another meeting of the Vision Team to review, offer changes, opinions and suggestions. After that, it is back to the drawing board with Meadows Elementary possibly being put on the fast track for construction. When that would take place we are not exactly sure, but Meadows Elementary could be near or at the front of the line. The architects are working on it so we will know "relatively soon" and keep you posted. #### This Holiday Season: Be Aware and Be Safe

The Meadows Place Police Department reminds everyone: The "Bad Guys" are shopping for the holidays too; they love the holidays as much as everyone else, especially because it's an opportune time for crime and are looking for opportunities to strike and take advantage for the Holiday Season.

Now more than ever is the time to be conscious of your surroundings and protective of your wares. Whether you are traveling out of town, just out for the evening, shopping by yourself or with children, below are a few precautions to help make your holidays a safer one.

#### If you are traveling:

- Avoid driving alone at night.
- Keep all car doors locked and windows closed while in or out of your car. Set your alarm or use an anti-theft device.
- Put an automatic timer on your lights
- Ask a neighbor to check up on your home
- Don't forget to have your mail and newspaper delivery stopped
- Contact Meadows Place Police Department and request a House Watch

#### If you are out of the house:

- Turn on lights and music or the TV so it looks as if someone is home
- Be sure that your doors and windows are locked
- Don't display your gifts where they can be seen from the outside
- If you plan to have packages delivered to your home, make sure you are home to accept them. If not, ask a neighbor or have the package be held at the nearest holding facility

#### If you are shopping:

- Stay alert and be aware of what's going on around you, Park in a well-lit space
- Be sure to lock your car, close windows, and hide

- shopping bags and gifts in the trunk
- Avoid carrying large amounts of cash; pay with a credit card whenever possible
- Don't overburden yourself with packages
- Deter pickpockets and purse-snatchers. Carry a purse close to your body in the front. If you are carrying a wallet, place it in an inside coat or front pants pocket
- If shopping with kids, have a plan in case you get separated. For the older children, have a central meeting spot designated. For the younger children teach them to go to a store clerk or security guard if you get separated. Be sure they know your name (not just mommy and daddy), cell phone number, and their address. Go over the dangers of strangers with them so they know who not to talk to or follow
- Check receipts to see whether your full credit card number appears. If a receipt has your full number on it, take a pen and thoroughly scratch it out
- Double check that you have your credit cards and check book after you pay for your items

#### **Phone Scams:**

- In this day in time there are many taking advantage of our generosity and susceptibility during the holiday season.
- Should you receive a phone call about owing money, having a warrant for arrest, or someone in need, do not give out any personal information, checking account or credit card information.
- Report such a call to the Meadows Place Police Department, and the Federal Trade Commission (https://www.consumer.ftc.gov) information (https://www.consumer.ftc.gov/articles/0076-phone-scams)

By following these tips, you may reduce your stress during the Holiday Season.

#### You Asked for It - You Got It

Greetings! Thank You for the warm welcome as I take on the Code Enforcement Officer position with the City of Meadows Place this past summer. I took the position at one of the times The City needed code enforcement the most. For a small City of just one square mile, there is no shortage of work that needs attention and whole lot improvements that we all can be a part of. We are developing and implementing new processes in Code Enforcement for case filing, records and even charges filing in Municipal Court for non-compliance. However, though we are diligently working day in and day out with every citizen of the City, we are asking for each and every one of you to help us in making sure our neighborhoods and the entire City of Meadows Place is and will continue to be... Your place for Life!

Please remember that there are some easy and simple things we all can do to help keep our City attractive not just for our visitors, but most especially for ourselves and to improve on:

- 1. Please remember to keep trees cut and trimmed. §130.07(B) It is unlawful for anyone to maintain trees, shrubs or other vegetative material upon a public street and/or public right-of-way less than the minimum clearance measured from the pavement to the lowest limb, branch or part thereof extending over the sidewalk and over the public street/pavement (Sidewalk: not less than 10 feet and Public Street: not less than 16 feet).
- 2. At all times, please remember to keep our lawns cut and trimmed. §91.039(A) It shall be unlawful for any person who shall own or occupy any lot or lots in the City to allow weeds/or grass to grow on the lot or lots to a height of more than nine (9) inches.
- 3. At all times, please keep our trash cans and recycle bins stored out of public view from the public street and/or public right-of-way (sidewalk) except during scheduled trash/recycle pickup. §130.09(D) Except when placed at curbside for pickup, garbage cans or receptacles shall at all times be stored behind a fence, enclosure or shall otherwise be screened from view.

 Put our trash out only on trash days or not more than 18 hours before a scheduled trash pickup. This includes lawn clippings, so be sure to tell your Lawn Contractor! - §130.09(A).

Thanks to you all in advance for your patience, understanding and cooperation! If you can, we encourage everyone to please reach out to your neighbors who may be in need of assistance, especially the elderly, during this season of giving. Simple acts of kindness goes a long way! Happy Holidays!



Meadows Place will provide a respite for Monarch butterflies enroute to Mexico during their annual migration thanks to the efforts of city officials and nonprofit groups.

The city is the first permitted prairie restoration site in power line right of way, according to Barbara Keller-Willy, executive director and founder of Monarch Gateway and president of the Native Prairies Association of Texas.

As a Monarch Host City, Meadows Place is converting 13 acres of ROW to a pollinators' habitat, including milkweed, on which Monarchs lay their eggs and on which caterpillars feed before they form a chrysalis.

#### **December 2018 Parks & Recreation**



Representatives of Wildlife Habitat Federation have treated the land for invasive plants and will begin to seed native plants within the first two weeks of December to create a habitat for pollinators. But it's more than that. "It will bring back what we used to have - the animals and plants that existed at one time," said Jim Willis, president of Wildlife Habitat Federation.

A grand opening will be scheduled at the new trailhead located directly behind the fieldhouse in McGrath Park. Date and time to be determined.
