## LIFEGUARDS & SWIM INSTRUCTORS

The City of Meadows Place is accepting applications for Summer 2020. Applications can be picked up and turned in at City of Meadows Place City Hall or Nature & Discovery Center @ 11938 Amblewood Dr. Must be 15 years of age.

If applying for the lifeguard position, you must pass the prerequisite requirements, and be available for the following lifeguard class:

**May 8 - 10**

**Prerequisites:** Minimum age: 15 years; Swim 300 yards continuously; Tread water for 2 minutes using only the legs; Complete a timed event within 1 minute, 40 seconds by starting in the water, swimming 20 yards, surface dive to a depth of 7 to 10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object, return to the surface and swim 20 yards on the back to return to the starting point, exit without using steps or ladder.

**\*Must attend all 3 days to become certified\***
