Be the safest solution

Roundabouts reduce crashes by 35% and reduce injuries by 76%. Two lane Roundabouts have also proven safer for pedestrians, bicycles and older drivers.

✓ Lessen Congestion

Roundabouts will increase traffic capacity by 30 to 50% and reduce stops by up to 95%... Our four lanes are like a pipeline that has four valves that have to be opened and closed every time it's used while the Roundabouts are like a pipeline that flows unimpeded. Two unblocked lines flow much more freely than four that stop cars 48,000 times a day.
