Dorrance Lane Construction

Statewide Services has been selected as the general contractor to complete the Dorrance Lane construction project between Kirkwood Road and Oxford Street.

The westbound (north) lane of Dorrance is continued to be closed between Kirkwood and Oxford Glen Road for reconstruction. The eastbound (south) lane will remain open, but will be restricted to one way traffic eastbound until the westbound (north) lane is reconstructed. Please do not block the flow of traffic on Dorrance while it is temporarily restricted to one lane.

As a part of the second leg of reconstruction, the contractor will begin pavement removal from 11518 to 11502 Dorrance Lane starting Monday, October 17, 2022, weather dependent. Please plan accordingly as there will not be access to those residential driveways for approximately a month. Affected residents will need to make arrangements to park on the new pavement or coordinate to use neighbors' driveways. The contractor is deliberately breaking the full reconstruction up into smaller sections so that residents can park closer to their homes. Throughout the project, mail and garbage service will be directly across the street from the affected homes until the new street is re-opened. Mailboxes will be re-set toward the end of construction.
