Maximum of 5 per class / Minimum of 2

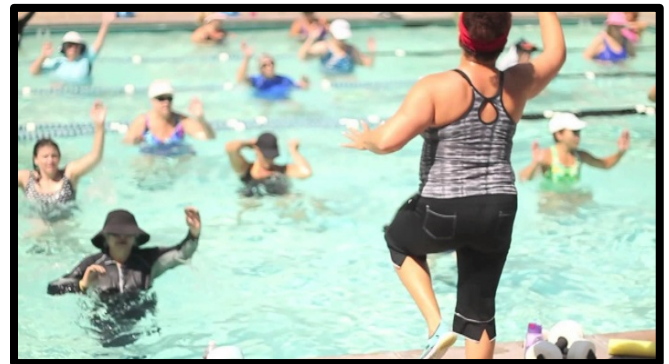
Sessions run Tues – Fri 2 weeks / 7 classes

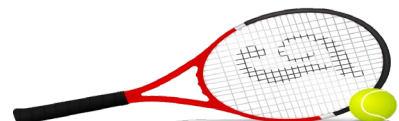
