

Lifeguard Job Description

Job Duties

- Maintain continuous surveillance of people in swimming pools and facility
- Enforce all pool rules stated on rule board
- Provide excellent customer service to the public
- Ensure appropriate headcount of people involved in a watersport on an hourly basis
- Provide safety information to people prior to them indulging in a water sport
- Supervise swimmers to ensure that they are swimming within the safety protocols
- Spot hazards or potential hazards and take measures to prevent accidents
- Control and report unruly behavior and evict individuals not adhering to behavior protocols
- Perform rescues in the event of drowning or swimming accidents
- Perform first aid and CPR according to the demands of adverse situations
- Perform pool chemical checks to ensure safety and hygiene
- Maintain accurate records of pool use and chemical levels
- Check safety of rescue tubes and buoys and perform needed maintenance
- Ensure that all pool equipment is stored safely
- Ensure that any lost items are kept in a safe place
- Maintaining a clean pool; duties will include brushing sides of the pool, vacuuming pool, scrubbing tiles, cleaning out skimmer baskets, skimming the pool for debris.
- Maintain clean operating facilities; duties will include cleaning restrooms, picking up trash from parking lots and around pool, removing trash from pool area trash cans, cleaning windows, cleaning & maintaining lifeguard room, cleaning & maintaining pool equipment areas, arranging deck furniture.
- Participate in City Events (some are mandatory)
- Other duties that may be assigned as needed.
- Attend job skills and sensitivity training provided by Meadows Place.

Requirements

- Minimum age of 15.
- Pass the prerequisite requirements
- Complete **ALL** training.
- Maintain a current lifeguard certification.
- NO cell phone use allowed.
