City Hall Flag Presentation

On Veterans Day, Congressman Pete Olson came to Meadows Place City Hall to present the city with a flag in honor of our veterans, past, present and future. This was not just any flag, but a flag that had flown over the Capital Building. In addition to the Congressman, we were honored to have several veterans and parents of veterans present - including Naval Petty Officer Jason Gill who looked dashing in his dress whites. Congressman Olson, himself a former naval aviator, had a long conversation with Jason who is now stationed in the Houston area as a recruiter. They talked about the ships they had served on and which type of ship they preferred, duties and Jason's future. Then the Congressman told everyone how much he valued the men and women in the military and how proud he was to see the Meadows Place Wall of Heroes, which he says is a very special tribute to the men and women who are putting themselves at risk while protecting the very freedoms we enjoy. The flag was carefully positioned in a flag frame and then placed in display case at City Hall where it will remain for all to see. I want to thank all the residents who attended this very special presentation as well as the veterans, their families, and of course, Congressman Olson who went out of his way to make this happen – and happen on Veterans Day. Road Use Fee

I have asked Council to consider attaching a Road Use Fee, similar to a municipal franchise fee, to our WCA Waste Corporation contract. Any funds generated by this fee would be specifically assigned to road repair. The fee is based on the fact that to do their job, the heavy trucks speed up the deterioration of our roads. Any amount assigned to WCA will be passed through to us, the residents, and will be added to our garbage fee. As an example, if Council agreed on a 10% Road Use Fee, then each home would a pay an additional \$1.81 per month garbage fee. This would generate a little over \$35,000 which could ONLY be used on roads and road repair. This is not a large amount but every little bit will help. To do this we must set a fixed percentage rate or a dollar amount and pass an ordinance, but, before we do this we will be asking for input from the residents of Meadows Place. I will keep you posted as the process progresses.

Tis the Season - Be Aware and Be Safe

The holidays are now upon us. This is the time of season where families often gather together, people are out and about shopping for gifts, the malls and grocery stores are packed, and the excitement swells.

This is also the time of year when thieves try to take advantage and look for opportunities to strike and make your holidays miserable.

Now more than ever is the time to be conscious of your surroundings and protective of your wares. Whether you are traveling out of town, just out for the evening, or shopping by yourself or with children, below are a few precautions to help make your holidays a safer one.

If you are traveling:

- Put an automatic timer on your lights
- · Ask a neighbor to check up on your home
- Don't forget to have your mail and newspaper delivery stopped
- Contact Meadows Place Police Department and request a House Watch

If you are out of the house:

- Turn on lights and music or the TV so it looks as if someone is home
- Be sure that your doors and windows are locked
- Don't display your gifts where they can be seen from the outside
- If you plan to have packages delivered to your home, make sure you are home to accept them. If not, as a neighbor or ask that the package be sent to the nearest post office

If you are shopping:

- Stay alert and be aware of what's going on around you
- Park in a well-lighted space
- Be sure to lock your car, close windows, and hide shopping bags and gifts in the trunk
- Avoid carrying large amounts of cash; pay with a check or credit card whenever possible
- Don't overburden yourself with packages
- Deter pickpockets and purse-snatchers. Carry a purse close to your body in the front. If you are carrying a wallet, place it in an inside coat or front pants pocket
- If shopping with kids, have a plan in case you get separated. For the older children, have a central meeting spot designated. For the younger children teach them to go to a store clerk or security guard if you get separated. Be sure they know your name (not just mommy and daddy), cell phone number, and their address. Go over the dangers of strangers with them so they know who not to talk to or follow
- Check receipts to see whether your full credit card number appears. If a receipt has your full number on it, take a pen and thoroughly scratch it out
- Double check that you have your credit cards and check book after you pay for your items

By following these tips, you can reduce your stress during the busy holiday season and be safe at the same time. Whatever holiday you celebrate, make it a safe one.

It is the relative's responsibility to coordinate with the Parks & Recreation Department the purchase, placement and removal of the plaque for the Wall of Heroes. The plaque is the property of the relative who purchased it and may be removed at any time.

Please contact the Park & Recreation Department below to be added to the Wall of Heroes. The service person's relative must purchase the Wall of Heroes plaque from *M* & *M* Awards & More. This is an 8"x10" oak veneer plaque with a 5"x7" plexi-glass photo cover and three lines of laser etched print which has the service person's name, branch of service and overseas area of deployment. A 5"x7" portrait photo is required, preferably in uniform and must be supplied to *M* & *M* Awards & More to be attached to the plaque. The cost of the plaque is approximately \$35.00 plus tax.

Fishing at the Lake!


