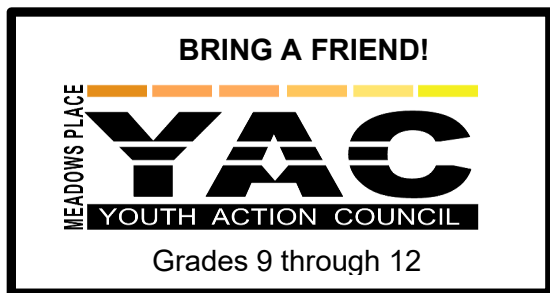
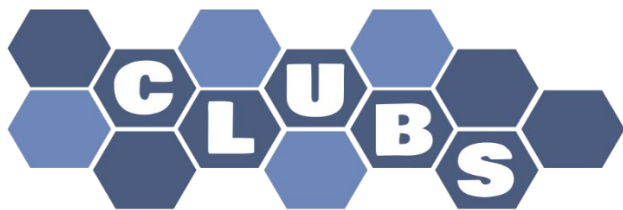

- Prices: \$75 Residents | Non-Residents \$250

Limit 1 card per household. Resident must show proof of residence at time of purchase. Cards will be good for 1 year from date of purchase.

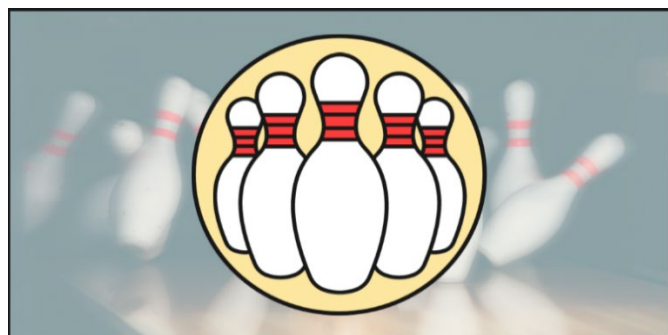
